Fees

Fees for the Lara Basketball Club are compulsory and contribute toward the cost of hall hire for training, registration and affiliation fees to BG and the cost of trophies at the end of the Championship (winter) season.

Fees are as follows:

LBC Annual Membership Fee

Annual LBC fees must be paid before the start of the Winter season. Players joining for Summer season only must pay summer season fees (1/2 of annual fees) before they play.



Introduction

Season Commences

Training Venue

All teams train at either the Lara Recreation Hall at Lara Primary School, Flinders Avenue, Lara or at Lara Lake Primary School, Forest Road, Lara. Training times vary for each team. Your coach will advise you of the time

Game Venue

All teams play at either The Arena Annex, Baxter Road, North Geelong or the Corio Leisuretime Centre, Anakie Road, Corio. Night/Day of play will depend on your age group and grading of the team you are selected in.

Equipment

Minimal equipment is required to play basketball. The Club provides everything required for training, and GABA provides equipment for match games. All you need is a good pair of shoes, Club uniform and a drink bottle.

Age Groups

The BG competition provides for boys and girls in the following age groups: Under 10, 12, 14, 16, 18 and 23, with Open grades for Men's and Women's teams.

Coaching

The Club provides coaches for each team as required. These coaches generally come from the Club's parent base and its committee. The Club is always looking for coaches, as without them, it cannot field a team. The Club will
